

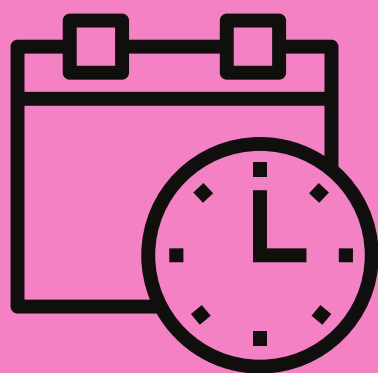
Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder

of Australian women consumed alcohol between conception and pregnancy recognition



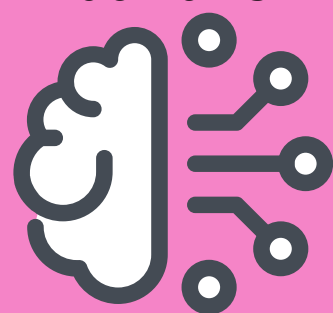
83%
